

Your Greener Coronation Checklist!

Planning ahead

Plan out who is bringing items like napkins, food, cakes, décor items etc to help avoid extra waste



Look into renting plates / cups / tables and chairs for your event (most rental businesses even do the washing up for you!) or ask people to bring their own

Visit charity shops for reusable items like cake stands, jugs, serving plates and tablecloths

The outfits

Consider if you will be having a dress code



Ask people to wear something they already have in their wardrobes for the party

Ask people to try buying their outfits second hand if they don't have anything to wear or swap with friends and neighbours

The food

Think about going for seasonal food like British grown salads and strawberries



Plan your portions and only buy what you need from the shops

Can you buy your ingredients or items from a local farm shop or farmers market?

The waste

Download the waste and royal recycling signs



Think of where a good spot would be to have your waste stations on the day

Plan who will oversee keeping an eye on these on the day

The décor

Ask who has bunting or flags you can use for the day



Can you go for reusable or paper and card décor items instead of single-use plastic?

Keep a list so you know who to return items to after the day

After the party

Ask people to bring a container to take food away after the event to avoid it being wasted



Plan who will be staying to help clean up
